CHANGES FOR 2025

Squirrels

Squirrels and their leaders are invited to come and spend the day with us on Saturday 5th July, price includes return transport from Chester to the Campsite. Squirrels will need to bring a packed lunch and we will provide them an evening meal before they return on the coaches home.

Beavers

New for '25 - Beaver Sleepover - Saturday 5th July - Beavers are invited to come and spend the day with us (similar to the Squirrels) with the added option to stay over night on the Saturday. Beavers will be able to join in evening activities and entertainment.

Beavers and their leaders will be settled into the large marquee for a 'Big Beaver Sleepover', the price for the Sleepover option includes travel from Chester to the campsite, Beavers will need to bring a packed lunch and we will provide them with the remainder of their meals before they are collected from the campsite on Sunday by parents after camp closing.

Beavers and their leaders also have the option of the day visit only, scouting supervision ratios for both need to be met.

Cubs and Scouts

As in previous years, a weekend filled with fun and exciting adventure, including (but not limited to) water sports, zip line, climbing wall, spider mountain, inflatables and scouting skills!

Explorers

New for '25 - Explorers are invited to join our very own **Chester Explorers Service Team**, where they will help ensure the smooth running of our District Camp. We are asking Explorers to pay £15 to cover camp fees and food costs for the weekend provided by us. Explorers will have downtime away from duties, including an evening water sports session and will also be able to participate in some activities during the day. Tasks include - helping to set up and run activities, site services, supporting water sports, helping the catering team, backwoods cooking, manning inflatables and running competitions.

A separate Explorer Only Camp will be ran a couple of weeks after District Camp where all Explorers are invited to attend.

30th November 2024 - Expression of interest closes/Group Deposits due - Once your group co-ordinator has completed the 'Expression of Interest' a deposit request for £100 per group will be payable by this date.

28th February 2025 - Deadline for final numbers to be submitted.

1st March 2025 - Groups will be issued invoices for 40% of the cost of their attendees.

31st March 2025 - Deadline for 40% invoices to be paid.

1st May 2025 - Groups will be issued with invoices for the remaining balance.

31st May 2025 - Deadline for remaining balance invoices to be paid.
