On Sunday, Leaders must take their youth members to the gate to be collected by parents. No parents should be allowed to enter the campsite. This is to ensure the safety and safeguarding of our youth members.

ALL Leaders staying overnight should be named on your Nights Away Notification (NAN) Form, try to have your NAN forms sent into the District by 14 June. Groups should have a nominated first aider who holds a valid first aid certificate.
